Introduction

Main Points of Sermon

God the Father is compassionate by virtue of His nature. Jesus is compassionate by virtue of His nature. As believers we the church are called to be compassionate.

Compassion is inter-personal.

For compassion to be roused there requires there to be a human need. Compassion is when that need is met.

Definition of Compassion – it is a form of love or care, that is roused within a person when they see others suffering, in peril, in need or in lack. This compassion then leads the person to action to fulfil the need of the person they love or care for.

Jesus in healing the leper gives us a perfect picture of compassion in action.
